Highlights of the Quarter

Following are the key GSMP highlights of October- December 2009:

GS1 Standards Development Event Autumn 2009	The GS1 Standards Development Event (Joint GSMP - EPCglobal JAG) held October 26-30, 2009, was a great success. The event was hosted by GS1 France and our sponsors included; GS1 in Europe, Crossgate, Tailorit, Generix Lascom, Equadis, CITC, CNRFID, Reseau Echangeur, and Pôle de Compétitivité des Industries du Commerce. It was a well attended event with a total of 343 attendees from 125 companies representing 33 countries and bringing standards development together to best serve users around the world.
GS1 XML Message Architecture Implementation Guide Released!	This document is intended to clarify the function, structure and usage of the GS1 XML Message Layered Architecture. It is targeted for technical implementers who need to know how to implement the GS1 XML Message Architecture in their environment.
Missing Identification Implementation Guide Released!	This implementation guide scopes the current missing identification challenges, proposes use case scenarios, and where feasible, recommends options to help supply chain partners identify items. It describes how to use the current available GS1 standards to solve missing identification primarily with serialisation.
GS1 Healthcare Standards Delivered	Global Standards for marking medical devices and pharmaceuticals to improve patient safety and traceability.
eCom Maintenance release 2.6 delivered	GS1 eCom XML standard messages have been aligned to GS1 Healthcare and Do It Yourself sectors requirements (Order, MultiShipment Order, ConfigureTo Order, Invoice, Invoice EU Extension, Common Library, Purchase Conditions, Request for Payment).
LCN expands to Mexico	LCN outreach now to Mexican community and tools now translated to Spanish.

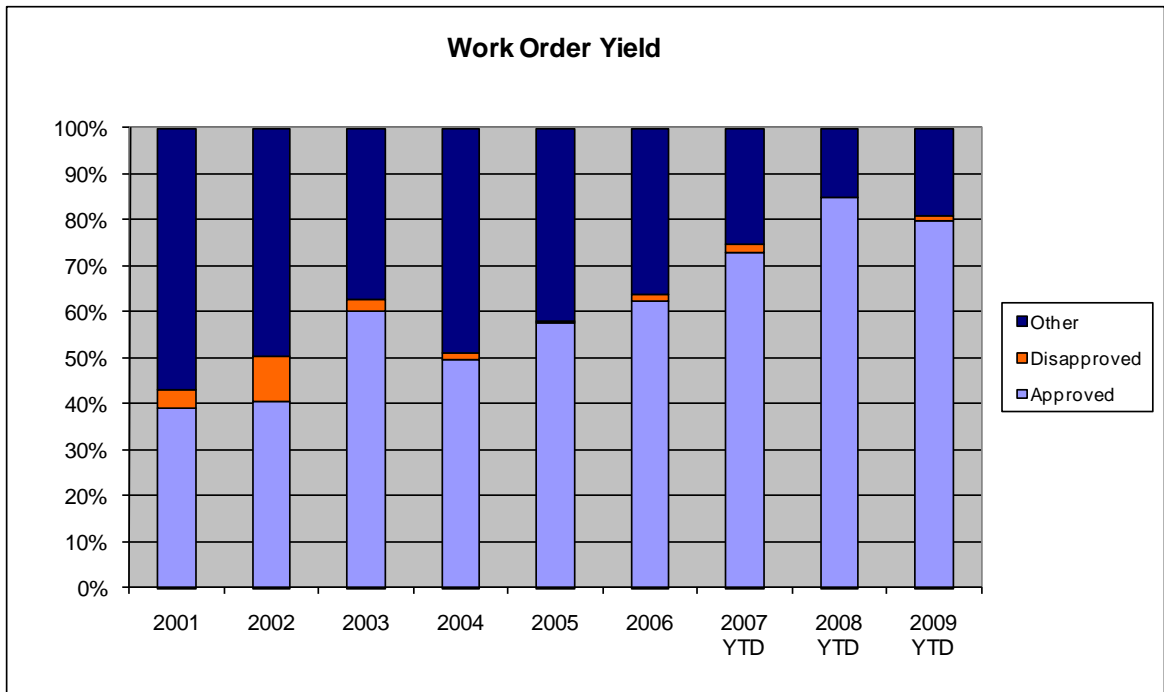

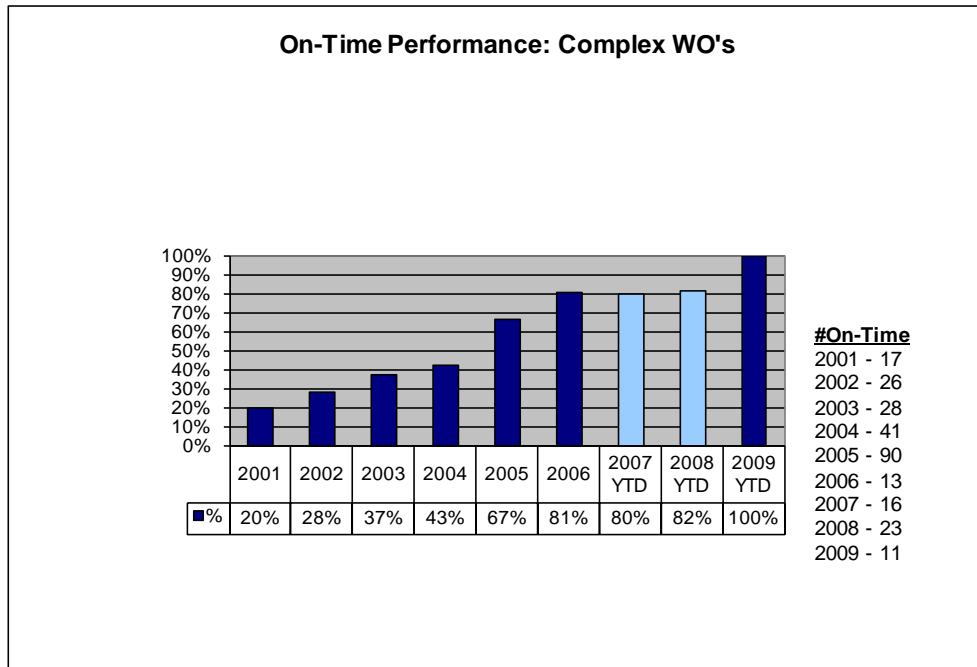

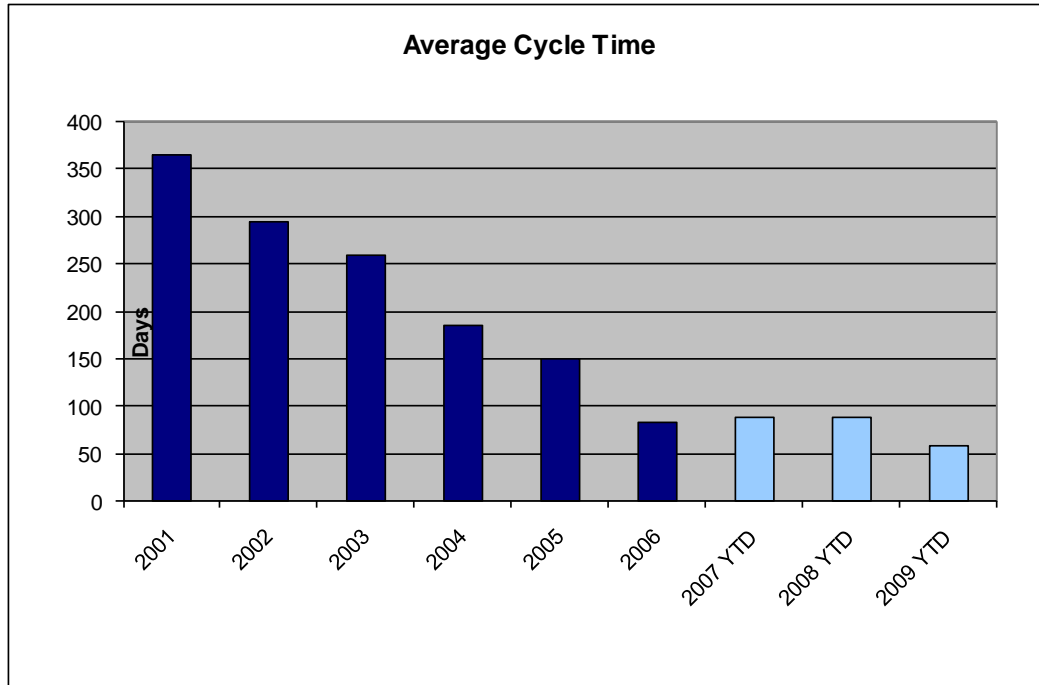
