Joint recommendations

For the avoidance of confusion affecting the primary packag and labelling of liquid pharmaceutical dosage forms

If there is space on the label, the following particulars should be added:

2. Identification codes

The use of standardised machine-readable identification codes on primary and secondary packaging is recommended. It is common practice to use the *Global Trade Item Number* (GTIN, as data structure) in the form of *Data Matrix Bar Codes* (2D, as data medium). The primary and secondary packaging are distinguished by a different GTIN. The Standards Organisation GS1 has published GTIN allocation rules to create global uniformity.⁷
