

- Inhalators


EAN-13 or GS1 DataMatrix + Infusions/injections



Percentages of barcodes on the packages (both EAN-13 and GS1 DataMatrix)










- ✓ To put focus on scanning

Missing barcodes





- ✓ The nurses take action
- ✓ Collaboration with GS1 Denmark and the Hospital Pharmacy
- ✓ To ensure scannable barcodes on every pack



The change process – importance of the leader



Clear leader + strong nurses on the floor

A cultural change must make sense for the individual nurse in order to succeed

Barcode scanning is not something you implement overnight





Barriers





- ✓ If new routines are not maintained you will not succeed
- ✓ If IT equipment does not function you will not succeed
- ✓ If IT equipment is placed in an impractical location you will not succeed
- ✓ If there is any resistance you will not succeed

Barcode scanning Process Project

"If you think of it as a project that can be implemented after a limited period and then left alone, it will not be a success – not a lasting one, at least."



Next step



2018: Nursing Director of the Clinic for Children and Adolescents with Surgical Diseases

- Five other specialties
- New group of nurses
- Want to achieve the same barcode scanning results



Methods



To a large extent transferring the work from the Department of Pediatric Surgery

Lessons learned:

- Staff turnover has increased
- Need for barcode scanning as part of the training for new employees
- Involvement of the internal improvement secretary
