


GSMP delivers in Q3

- An addendum to the Identification of Components and Parts in the Rail Industry Application Standard to add dos and don'ts for Identification of Components and Parts
- Updates to the Healthcare GLN Implementation Guideline to provide implementation guidance for those considering the use of the GS1 Global Location Number (GLN) in healthcare
- Updates to the General Specifications Standard to separately identify pieces of a large trade item when the pieces are shipped separately in some quantity within different logistic units
- Updates to the General Specifications Standard to meet a regulatory requirement for a Marine Requirement Certificate
- A new Application Standard for Uniform Resource I dentifier (URI) Structure (now known as GS1 Digital Link) to define a standard structure for URIs that enables reliable encoding of GS1 identifiers and sub-identifiers, regardless of domain name, such that those keys can be extracted without looking up information on (or even being connected to) the web
- Updates to the Product Image Specification i3.2 Standard for images saved with transparent backgrounds

- A new Mobile Ready Hero I mages Guideline for product images presented in online retail environments on small screens, typically alongside 'add to basket' function Updates to the Product Image Specification i3.2 Standard for images saved with transparent backgrounds
- Updates to the Core Business Vocabulary Standard for the addition of attributes for fish Traceability
- Updates to the Global Data Synchronisation (GDS) Trade
 I tem Implementation Guideline for the usage of GS1 additional country codes and how they should be used for Target Market
- A small release to the Global Data Synchronisation Standard, Maintenance release 3.1.7; Attributes, Codelist and Validation Rules
