Global Standards Management Process (GSMP)

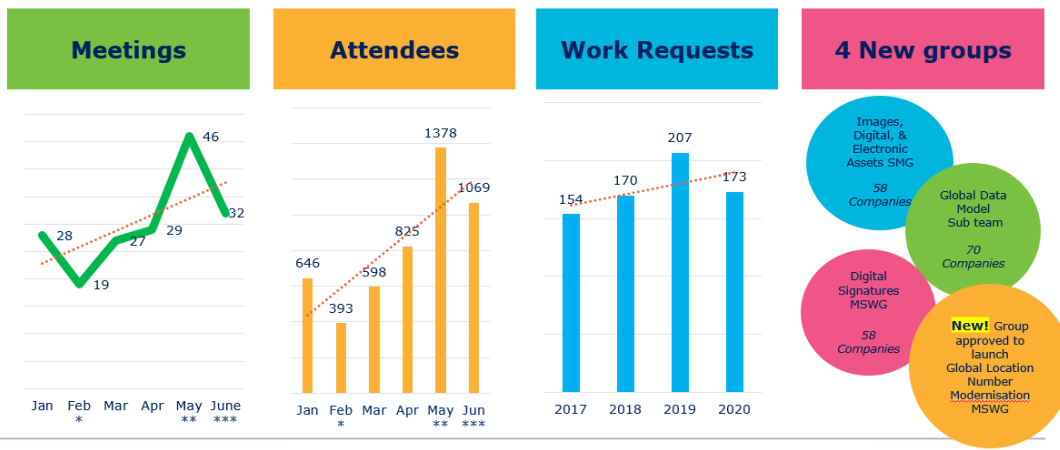
