


## USAID Supply Chain for Health Commodities

- Successful implementation of USG health programs, in partner countries, is dependent on an uninterrupted supply of health commodities.
- Since 2005, USAID has procured and delivered more than 4,300 different products (FP, Malaria, HIV)
- USAID support also included more than \$800 million in systems strengthening technical assistance in more than 50 countries
- On Jan 2016 USAID awarded the GHSC- Procurement and Supply Management (PSM) focused on:
  1. Global Supply Chain
  2. In Country Systems Strengthening
  3. Strategic Engagement



# Commodity Flow in USAID Supply Chain




## Goals through adoption of global standards

## **Reproductive Health Global Traceability Advisory Group (RH GTAG)**

A forum established in November 2015 for subject matter experts from industry and the public sector to discuss and provide recommendations for the adoption and implementation of global standards for RH product identification, data capture, and data exchange in the supply chain.

Marking of application identifiers on packaging and labeling



## SHARE

Exchange of master and transactional data



## USE

Data management; streamline processes; track and trace



To share, organizations need to register with GHSC-PSM's Supplier Portal for transactional data and the Global Data Synchronization Network (GSDN) for master data




# GHSC-PSM'S PLANS FOR GSI SUPPORT AND GDSN DATA POOL INTEGRATION



## GHSC-PSM'S Plans for Data Management

1. Supplier registers with GSI and obtains a prefix
2. Supplier assigns GTINs to its products
3. Supplier registers with a GDSN data pool provider
4. Supplier agrees to provide product attributes based on GHSC-PSM's requirements through GDSN Data Pool
