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



# REAL GDP Growth (Index) in CEE (source: European Commision 2015)




## GDP growth and inflation rate in Poland (National Bank of Poland)




### Retail sales and industrial production growth in Poland






### Poland has 2 Core Network Corridors crossing its country






### FDI IN POLAND IN 2013 BY THE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN





### **EMPLOYMENT IN TRANSPORT ATION AND EDUCATION**

Persons with tertiary level of education employed in transportation and storage in relation to total employment in this sector in Poland (2015 Q1, in thousands)


