### A message from Mark Holmes, GS1 Vice President of Standards Development

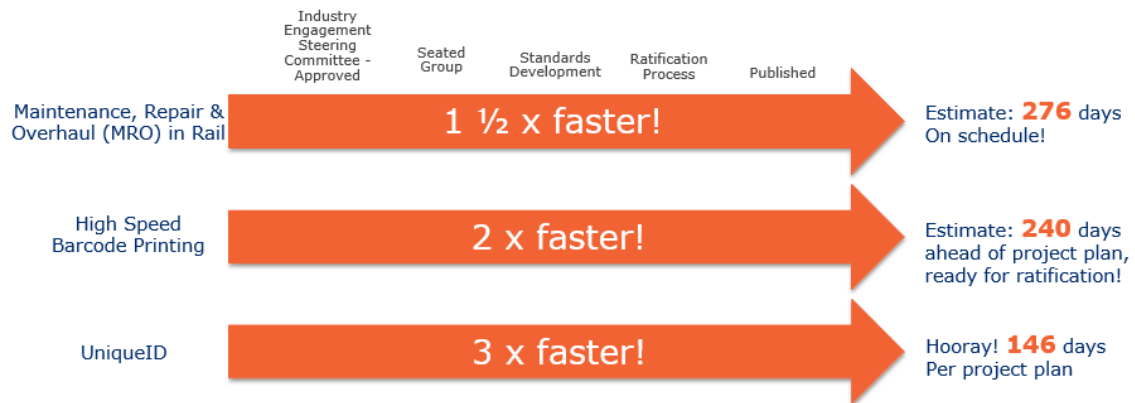
